

## WE NEED A SHOCK OF AUTHORITY SAID VALERIE PECRESSE PDT PARIS ILE DE FRANCE

### ABOUT IMMIGRATION & STATE MEDICAL AID

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**USPA NEWS** - Valerie Pecresse, President of the Paris Ile de France Region (The Republicans), has just replied to President Emmanuel Macron, in an interview on the JDD (Journal Du Dimanche), accusing him of "doing a double language and even a double Game " She refers to the "authority" in the face of immigration, especially for medical aid (which has been denounced as misused, such as cosmetic surgeries used by this fund by immigrants), right to asylum, expulsion, development aid, deportation to the border. Valerie Pecresse says she wants to "negotiate the return to their countries of origin" isolated minors and foreign prisoners, conditioning these returns to development aid. Regarding the AME (State Medical Aid, which costs 1 billion € / year) Valerie Pecresse, President of the Region Ile de France, considers that "what attracts illegal immigrants in France is not full employment, but the generosity of the social policy ", wishes" the restriction of the MEA to the only basket of necessary care "and suggests not granting a residence permit to people" who come to France to seek treatment ".

### PRESIDENT MACRON TALKS TO MAJORITY PARLIAMENTARIANS ABOUT IMMIGRATION-----

The Head of State and (Founder of the En Marche movement, of which the majority of the current members of LREM), is addressed to deputies, in the gardens of the Ministry of Relations with Parliament: it is necessary "to prepare our country for contemporary challenges who scare ". The President of the Republic clearly dictates a new priority of the government, for several weeks, which will be immigration, because it will be one of the main issues of this political axis, the eve of the municipal elections. Indeed, President Macron said this week in front of parliamentarians of the majority LREM (The Republic in March), his will to make immigration a priority issue, and pending the debate on this topic in the National Assembly, Monday, September 30th. He explained to them that he does not become "a bourgeois party". He then opposes the Bourgeois and immigration: "The Bourgeois who do not believe in immigration" and "the poorest who are the receptacle", "By claiming to be humanistic, we are sometimes too lax", President Macron adds: "The bourgeois have no problem with that: they do not cross it. The popular classes live with "(Ca: means in this context immigration)". Since then, these sentences pronounced by President Macron, these phrases your shock, some left-wing politics were extreme left and fuels the appetite of the far right mine Le Pen, which suddenly called for a referendum on immigration, and donning one after another on long televised debates about immigration. It is in the same logic that Valerie Pecresse gave this shock interview in the Journal du Dimanche, a newspaper widely read by politicians.

### THE PRESIDENT OF PARIS ISLAND OF FRANCE VALERIE PECRESSE DEFIES THE PRESIDENT ON HIS WORDS OF IMMIGRATION

The president of the Île-de-France Region, Pecresse, is therefore challenging the government. "We no longer need debaters, but actors," she says, before unveiling her proposals such as the tightening of social benefits, reduced rates in transport or medical aid state (AME), the restrictions of our asylum policy, through quotas or the introduction of a visa tax for non-EU nationals.

To the JDD question "Emmanuel Macron wants to make immigration a priority subject. Are you convinced? Valerie Pecresse replied, "I ask the President to put an end to the discrepancy between his words, which are martial, and his actions, which are weak. He is constantly in a double language, even a double game: he tells the French what they want to hear. I ask him not to have the trembling hand. Now you have to decide. For Valerie Pecresse, the acquisitions of the French nationality "must not be automatic anymore"

To another question from the JDD: "Everything is to be thrown in terms of migration policy? Valerie Pecresse replied: "I do not see any break with François Hollande's policy. Some say that President Macron is right? But remember the program of the right, including that of Alain Juppé. It contained the immigration quotas, voted each year by Parliament, and the denial of the right of the soil for children born to foreign parents in an irregular situation. Finally, the acquisition of French nationality must no longer be automatic. You have to ask for it, to desire it. Not getting it at 18 in a surprise pouch. France, it must be a choice. To another question of the JDD: "Should we be sorry for the fact that France remains an attractive country? "Valerie Pecresse replied:" We must comb our social policy to end the benefits undue. I do not agree with the National Gathering: I believe that state medical aid [AME] and the schooling of children must be continued. But I am for the restriction of the MEA to the only basket of necessary care: for example, a serious illness, a virus or a health emergency. Today, the beneficiaries of the AME are 100% covered! To another question of the JDD: The question of immigration is therefore first of all that of social benefits? Valerie Pecresse replied: "Yes, it is decisive. We must put an end to all forms of abuse. A
